Attached for your information is a letter to the Lord Mayor from the South East City Residents Association (SECRA) concerning the Government's proposal to build a hotel at the Adelaide Oval.

As can be seen from the letter SECRA supports the Lord Mayor's strong stand against the proposal for the development of a hotel at the Adelaide Oval. The Park Lands should not be used for commercial ventures and such a hotel would establish a precedent that could well put our Park Lands at risk of further commercial developments.

Also SECRA is most concerned that the Government did not consult with the City of Adelaide Council about this proposal and saw fit to only brief the Council on the day before informing the public about the project.

SECRA is concerned that your lack of consultation does not auger well for the establishment of good working relationships with the City of Adelaide Council or show an understanding of the fact that the Council is responsible for the Park Lands on behalf of all South Australians

SECRA is of the view that the State Government should be consulting with the City of Adelaide as a good working relationship must surely be beneficial and result in successful outcomes.
